Scope of Eligibility: Open to applicants who meet the requirements below.

Description: Under the supervision of a Crew Supervisor or other supervisory officer in the Fish and Wildlife Program, Department of Environmental Protection, performs various unskilled and semi-skilled work involved in fish and game propagation, growth and health maintenance, resource inventories, fish and game distribution, user surveys, habitat management and performs routine maintenance of buildings, equipment and grounds; does other related work.

Specific to the Position: Appointee will be required to operate various types of equipment, utilize hand and power tools in Wildlife Management Areas in the Central Region; perform semi-skilled maintenance on buildings and grounds; perform wildlife habitat maintenance; work on various types of terrain in varying weather conditions; may be required to lift materials and/or supplies up to 75 lbs. Flexible work hours based on duties assigned; may be on call for emergency situations.

Preferred Skill Set: Familiarity with general maintenance for buildings and grounds; familiarity with the use of and safety with hand or power tools and other equipment; familiarity with Wildlife Management Areas and habitat maintenance

Requirements

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

Appointee may be required to obtain a valid New Jersey boat operator's license.

Appointees may be required to possess a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and applicable endorsements for the class and type of vehicle being operated.

Other: Appointee may be required to wear a half-face respirator and complete an annual training course in respiratory protection.

Residency: All persons newly hired on or after September 1, 2011 have one year from the date of employment to establish, and then maintain principal residence in the State of New Jersey subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 (L.2011, Chapter 70), also known as the "New Jersey First Act".

Authorization to Work: Selected candidates must be authorized to work in the United States per the Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services regulations. **Note:** The State of New Jersey does not provide sponsorship for citizenship to the United States.
