Subject Updates on the Remedial Action Permitting Process

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection recently adopted amendments to N.J.A.C. 7:26B, 7:26C, 7:26E, and 7:26F that resulted in significant changes to the Remedial Action Permit (RAP) process. To implement these amendments, Contaminated Site Remediation & Redevelopment offers the following updates:

- The following six [RAP forms and instructions](#) were posted. These forms now include soil, ground water and indoor air components, updated regulatory citations, requirements for monitoring plans and fees, and information regarding Financial Assurance (FA) exemptions.
